Before joining the CERI in 2003, he served as expert in charge of ex-ante assessment at the Ministry of Economy in Warsaw (2002-2003) and as a special advisor at the OECD for the Territorial Review Poland, (2008 He has been a consultant for the Asian Development Bank from 2006 till 2015 within Southeast Asia working on a comparative study of regional integration, growth poles and dams issues within the Greater Mekong Subregion. Since 2015 his research attention has focused on energy policies and energy poverty. He is the co director of the the *Masters in Global Energy Transitions and Governance* (https://www.cife.eu/en/3/master-in-global-energy-transition-and-governance_126-1) at the european Institute, CIFE (<http://www.cife.eu/>).
