

CAF VISITING PROFESSORSHIP AT CERI SCIENCES PO CALL FOR APPLICATIONS 2015

The CAF Visiting Professorship at CERI Sciences Po offers an opportunity for mid-career Latin American scholars to develop their research within the foremost French research center dedicated to international relations and regional studies.

The Visiting Professorship, endowed by the Development Bank of Latin America (CAF) is open to nationals and permanent residents of one of the following CAF member countries: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Jamaica, Mexico, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Portugal, Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, Uruguay and Venezuela.

Research areas

Scholarship in social studies related to one of the five CERI research areas:

- Security: conflicts, violence and peacemaking; crime, police and justice; risks and disasters; provisions and predictions.
- International politics: theory of international relations; foreign policy; international organizations and NGOs; international order.
- Capitalism and globalization: Europeanization and other forms of regional cooperation and integration; markets and regulation; historical sociology of the economy.
- Political frames: state formation; political systems, modes of domination and collective action; material culture of politics.
- Identity and politics: nationalism and transnationalism; ethnicity; religion; mobility and migrations; memory, politics of the past and historical narratives.

Benefits

- Travel expenses to cover outward and return flight to Paris of up to €2000.
- Living allowance (stipend) of a total of €2500 per month.
- Affiliation with CERI for a period of 3 months from October to December 2015.
- A workspace at CERI and free access to Sciences Po library.
- The opportunity to participate in the center's research activities, in particular those of OPALC (*Observatorio Político de América Latina y del Caribe*).

Selection requirements

- Current affiliation as a permanent faculty member of a higher-education institution in one of the above mentioned CAF member countries.
- A completed Ph.D. and a professional academic experience of minimum 7 and maximum 10 years.
- A strong research proposal within the scope of CERI research areas.
- Evidence of previous publications in peer-reviewed journals and of other previous academic accomplishments
- A working knowledge of French would be considered an advantage.

How to apply

Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- A current CV.
- A one-page cover letter.
- A personal statement describing the candidate's previous experience and explaining how the CAF Visiting Professorship will contribute to his/her future career or research plans.
- A description of the proposed research project (not more than 5000 words with a strong focus on methodology and sources).
- Recommendation letters from two referees (academics only).

Applications are to be sent, by email exclusively, **before March 15, 2015** to:
