CAF-CERI/Sciences Po Visiting Fellowship Call for applications

The Center for International Studies and Research (CERI) of Sciences Po offers an opportunity for **junior or mid-career Latin American scholars** to develop their research within the foremost French research center dedicated to international studies.

The fellowship is endowed thanks to a grant funded by the **Development Bank of Latin America (CAF)** and is open to nationals and permanent residents of one of the following countries: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Jamaica, Mexico, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Portugal, Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, Uruguay and Venezuela.

The fellowship is intended to support **scholarship in social studies** related to one of the five CERI research areas:

- **Security and risks:** conflicts, violence and pacification; crime, police and justice; risks and disasters; previsions and predictions.
- **International politics:** theory of international relations; actors and processes of foreign policy-making; international organizations and NGOs; new configurations of the international order.
- **Capitalism and globalization:** Europeanization and other sub-levels of international politics; regional cooperation and integration; markets and regulation; comparative historical sociology of the economy.
- **Political trajectories:** State formation; imperial fabrics; political orders, modes of domination and collective action; material cultures.
- **Identities and politics:** constructions of identity, nationalism and transnationalism; sociology and politics of identity; imaginaries and practice of religion; international mobility and migrations; memory, politics of the past and historical narratives.

Benefits

- **Travel expenses** to cover return flight to Paris, France, of up to €2000.
- **Living allowance** (stipend) of a total of €2500 per month.
- Affiliation to CERI for the **period of 1 to 3 months**.
- A **workspace** with a computer at CERI, located in the prestigious 6th district of Paris.
- A university card and access to Sciences Po library, the largest social sciences library in continental Europe.
- The opportunity to **participate in the center's research activities**, in particular those of OPALC (*Observatorio Político de América Latina y del Caribe*), to present research papers, and to publish in CERI's journal or working papers series.

Selection requirements

- A completed Ph.D. and a **professional academic experience of minimum 5 years**.
- A **strong research proposal** within the scope of one of the above-mentioned CERI research areas.
- Evidence of **previous publications in peer-reviewed** journals and of other previous academic accomplishments
- A working knowledge of French would be considered an advantage.

How to apply

Applicants are required to submit the following to the address below:

- A current CV.
- A one-page cover letter.
- A personal statement describing the candidate's previous experience and explaining how this fellowship will contribute to his/her future career or research plans.
- A description of the proposed research project (not more than 5000 words with a strong focus on methodology and sources).
- Names and details of two referees.
