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EU - ASEAN

- EU ASEAN merchandise trade in 2010 € 145 bn, dominated by manufacturing
- EU accumulated FDI stocks in ASEAN in 2009: € 163 bn
- EU services export surplus with ASEAN in 2009:
 € 2.2 bn
- Top EU trading partners, by rank: Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Indonesia, Vietnam, Philippines
