For all universities: REGISTER FOR AND VALIDATE THE EQUIVALENT OF AT LEAST 60 ECTS per year

- Minimum workload is calculated in 8 courses per year (60 ECTS)
 (4 courses per semester is the equivalent of 30 ECTS)
 Variations:
 - ➤ UTS has a 24 UTS credit points = 30 ECTS structure. Students can take either 4 x 6cp subjects, or 3 x 8cp subjects. Both of these are considered a full time study load worth 24 UTS cp i.e. 30 ECTS. Subjects at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences and some Law subjects are 8 credit points.
 - ➤ UNSW has August Term + Term3 + January Term + Term1 (August Term: 1 course + Term3: 3 courses+ January Term: 1 course+ Term1: 3 courses)
- Major validation per year is calculated in 3 courses (1.5 courses per semester). Check the Discipline/Major equivalence online.
 Variations:
 - > Major validation at UTS is still 3 courses per year!

KEIO: Minimum 22 Japanese credits per year (11 per semester). Major: 9 Japanese credits per year

SOPHIA: Minimum 28 Japanese credits per year (14 per semester). Major: 11 Japanese credits per year

U. of TOKYO: Minimum 28 Japanese credits per year (14 per semester). Major: 14 Japanese credits per year

TUFS: Minimum 22 Japanese credits per year (11 per semester). Major: 9 Japanese credits per year

WASEDA: Minimum 26 Japanese credits per year (13 per semester). Major: 10 Japanese credits per year

- Major validation is calculated in 10 Korean credits per year (5 Korean credits per semester).
 Check the Discipline/Major equivalence online.

We strongly recommend you validate most of your Major-related courses during the 1st semester

- GEOGRAPHICAL SPECIALISATION: Validate 2 courses related to your area (max. 1 language course)
- If you are taking a Korean language programme you shall validate 2 social sciences units per semester on top of the language courses
