Waseda University Visiting faculty exchange program

Waseda University, an old and prestigious private university in Japan, is one of Sciences Po's strategic partners in Japan, not only for student exchange, but also for scientific activities under the [WasePo Dialogue](#). The theme of cooperation between our 2 universities has been defined under the framework of "Humans and Mobilities".

"Humans and Mobilities" aims at capturing the complex significance of people's mobilities in the early 21 st century around the world and its utmost relevance to understand social, economic and political change. It entails research ranging from geography to economics and demography, as well as sociology, anthropology, political science and international relations. It also allows for crossover between "hard" sciences (such as life science) and social sciences.

Within the frame of our Memorandum of Understanding, Sciences Po is committed to send up to 2 visiting faculty members to conduct research or to teach in Japan alongside with the invitation of up to 2 researchers from Waseda hosted by our research community.

CONDITIONS

- Duration of the stay: minimum 2 weeks - maximum 2 months.
- Eligibility: To be a member of Sciences Po's academic community for more than 6 months - and to be under 65 years-old.
- Requirements: To be actively involved in a program related to the theme "[Humans and Mobility](#)"
- Living allowances: up to 320.000 yens (depending on the conversion rate, around 2500 euros on a per diem basis).
- Transportation: Covered by the Sciences Po Research Centre or the beneficiary
- Accommodation: Waseda will support the visiting faculty to find affordable accommodation.

APPLICATION

Application materials include the following documents and must be submitted in English:

- A full CV, including a list of publications
- A personal statement, including research project and specificities
- A letter of invitation from a Waseda researcher
