



CEE Associate Research Fellows' Charter

1. The status of associate researcher at the Centre for European Studies and Comparative Politics at Sciences Po (UMR8239) is granted, by decision of the laboratory's unit council, for a period of three years, renewable, to researchers and/or teaching-researchers.

Applications must be submitted before the 1st of February of each calendar year for the first session and the 1st of September for the second, addressed to Eleonora Russo, General Secretary of the CEE (eleonora.russo@sciencespo.fr), and should include:

- a CV and a comprehensive list of publications
- a research project indicating the candidate's integration into the scientific programs conducted by the CEE, and referencing effective, past, or future collaborations with permanent researchers of the Center.

The unit council examines the applications and makes decisions twice a year, during its meetings in March and October.

For young PhD holders from the CEE, the status of associate researcher is granted for a duration of three years, not renewable, upon written request to be sent, according to the same schedule, to Florence Faucher, Director of the CEE (copy to Eleonora Russo). Its aim is to maintain an institutional link between the young PhD holder and the center to which they were affiliated during their thesis.

- 2. Associate researchers actively participate in the collective life of the CEE in several ways: they are integrated into research projects; they take part in scientific events and may organize them; they attend General Assemblies of the CEE and can be consulted regarding the center's institutional and scientific project.
- 3. The associate status allows:
 - participation in the scientific activities of the CEE
 - occasional solicitation of shared workspace at the CEE
 - access to a Sciences Po library card
 - having a personal page on the CEE website (linking to their institutional page)
 - administrative support for research project management (subject to certain conditions defined by specific rules of project calls and with the agreement of the CEE management)
- 4. Associate researchers are required to adhere to a scientific signature charter. The use of the Sciences Po, CEE logo, or name is reserved for publications presenting research results obtained within the scope of activities related to the project presented during the affiliation application. However, its use is prohibited for opinion articles or media interventions.
- 5. Associate researchers submit a report on research activities conducted in connection with the CEE two months before the expiration of their associate status.
