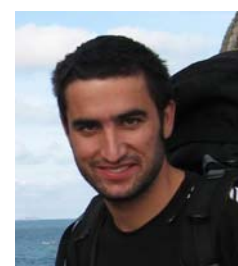
##### Emiliano Grossman (Sciences Po, CEE)
