Kerry H. Whiteside (Government Franklin and Marshall College, visiting Professor at Sciences Po, CEE)



Kerry H. Whiteside is a professor of political science, with specialization in modern political theory.

His main research themes are Twentieth-century political theory, environmental political theory, theories of representative democracy and deliberative democracy.

Publishing in both English and French, he is the author of four books and numerous articles, which have appeared in such journals as *Environmental Ethics*, *Le Débat*, *Environmental Politics*, *Polity*, *French Politics*, *Culture and Society*, and *Contemporary Political Theory*.

His current project, in collaboration with Prof. Dominique Bourg of the Université de Lausanne, is a book titled *Democracy and Finitude: On the Limits of Representation in Governing Nature*.
