I. State of Play

Buzzwords

- EU 2020 European added value
- "Focus on results" conditionalities
- Concentration critical mass, menu
- Integrated policy c.p. as main tool
- Territorial cohesion strength in diversity
- Solidarity c.p's own objectives...

I. State of Play

- Forces (simplified)
 - Net contributors "reduce contribution to EU budget"
 - Net recipients "solidarity"
 - MS Cohesion policy managers "results vs. rules"
 - Commission / DG Regio "EU added value"
 - Stakeholders of other policies "new challenges"
- Leading to... (apparently)
 - Top-down push towards EU 2020 and away from cohesion
 - Bottom-up push for cohesion and against reform
 - Outside pressure to replace the policy with other tools

II. Dilemmas

Strategic

- Impact ≠ EU 2020
- Debate on Coh. Policy link to other debates?
- Simplification debate lost
- Bottom-up needed for acceptance & success

Practical

- Evaluations of 2007-2013? Where to go?
- Contract vs. a programme? More? Binding?
- Concentration may reduce absorption
- No other development tools available in some MS
- No guarantee that funds will be there...

III. A basis for progress?

- EU 2020 is an accepted focal point
 - ←→ incomplete and biased
- Focus on results general desire
 - ←→ simplification debate "lost"
- Territorial cohesion "upgraded"
 - ←→ risk to collide with top-down approach
- Solidarity with "poorest" undisputed
 - ←→ loses if put in contrast to competitiveness

Σ How to solve it, then?

Do

- Stress link to other policies
- Reform program structure
- Have all EU 2020 addressed
- Use core indicators
- Strong positive conditionality
- Strengthen link to national policy
- Integrate non-subsidy tools
- Relaunch simplification debate

Do not

- Focus on input and not output
- Think that top-down cleverer
- Change what works
- Absorb "new tasks" into cohesion policy without a guarantee for funding
- Be more shy than opponents
