

Form of undertaking for visiting scholars hosted at the Centre for Research on Social Inequalities, Sciences Po

Integration and Contribution to the Research Center

1. As part of its scientific policy, the Centre for Research on Social Inequalities (CRIS) at Sciences Po promotes incoming and outgoing scientific visitorships in collaboration with scholars from other universities who share an interest in the research topics and scientific approaches of CRIS researchers.

Visiting scholars at CRIS are provided with a desk, badge, email account and access to documentation resources. Before their visit, visiting scholars are required to identify a CRIS permanent researcher who is interested in engaging in scientific exchanges and potential collaborations with them. This researcher will be designated as their CRIS referent and will be responsible for supporting their integration into the research center. The CRIS referent is present at the CRIS during the period of the visitorship. Visiting scholars commit to contributing to the scientific life of CRIS by engaging in scientific exchanges with their referent and with both junior and senior colleagues as well as by participating in CRIS scientific seminars. If for any reason the calendar of their visitorship changes, or they cannot participate in the scientific life of the center, they must communicate it immediately to their referent and to the Director of the CRIS. Visiting scholars (when applicable) must specify that their results stem from their stay.

2. Compliance with Sciences Po's Internal Rules

Visiting scholars must read and adhere to the internal rules of Sciences Po, including those related to the use of IT resources. They must follow best practices regarding intellectual property and maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary, confidential, or unpublished information encountered during their visit. They will not use the names or logos of Sciences Po or CRIS, except in relation to their participation in a Sciences Po project and with prior permission from the CRIS Director.

3. Consent to Data Processing

At the end of visiting period, the visiting scholars deliver a short report regarding their scientific activity at CRIS. They consent to the processing of the personal data submitted to Sciences Po during their visit. This data may be used for purposes related to their work at CRIS, their health and safety, and for any other purpose authorized by data protection legislation.
