



## CHARTER FOR RESEARCHERS AFFILIATED WITH CRIS

The Director of the Centre for Research on Social Inequalities (CRIS) (UMR7049) designates affiliated researcher status to colleagues who are affiliated with another main institution, upon the proposal of a permanent CRIS researcher, after consultation with members of the laboratory council. This status is formalized by the signature of a letter of commitment by the Director and the affiliated researcher.

The purpose of the charter is to specify the conditions under which affiliated researchers will be welcomed at CRIS.

Affiliate status allows :

- Participation in CRIS activities, scientific events, and research projects;
- Obtaining a Sciences Po library card;
- Publication of biographical information on the CRIS website;
- Participation in CRIS General Meetings;
- Occasional use of a shared workspace.

## Applications

The CRIS laboratory board examines the applications.

Applications must include :

- a CV (including a complete list of publications)
- a research project outlining the candidate's involvement in CRIS research, with reference to current collaborations with permanent CRIS researchers.

Affiliation lasts for two years, renewable on presentation of a justified request:

- three months before the expiry of their affiliation status, affiliates submit a report outlining the activities carried out in connection with CRIS (participation in research projects and publications with CRIS researchers, participation in seminars and organization of scientific events, article or project review activities).
- Any request for renewal must include the work schedule for the next two years and the name(s) of the CRIS member(s) involved.
- a CV (including a complete list of publications)

Affiliated researchers agree to abide by the rules of the scientific signature charter. Use of the logo or the name Sciences Po, CRIS is reserved for publications presenting research results produced within the framework of activities related to the project presented at the time of the affiliation request. The logo may not be used for opinion articles or media appearances.
