The researcher is welcomed to become associated with the Berlin Graduate School of Global and Transregional Studies.

Job description:

The research fellows will carry out independent empirical research in a topic covered by the project group and complete a PhD with reference to the project; they will contribute to publication of the results in German and English language and to organize scientific workshops. There are no teaching obligations attached to the position.

Requirements:

Applicants should have a degree in political science with a specialization in European integration and/ or comparative politics.

Desirable:

Focus on one or more of the following topics: implementation, legal systems and administration, and/ or EU policy-analysis in competition or anti-discrimination policy; a strong background in empirical methods; fluency in English; high ability to communicate and work in a team; structured, analytical and independent way of working;
additional assets: knowledge of the European legal system, command of French, experience with comparative / European research designs and in applying for and working with third-party research grants are assets.
