A/several grader(s) for Ms. Cornelia Woll master's core curriculum lecture course entitled Introduction to the International Political Economy

The global economy is the historic result of political decisions, but it also shapes politics and society in very specific ways. This introduction proposes a multidisciplinary perspective on the evolution of the global political economy and its effects on national politics. Based on insights from political science, sociology, anthropology, economics and history, we will study what may appear as rather technical issues in macroeconomics. We will cross the boundaries between economics and politics and move from the national to the international arena and back. Student will gain familiarity with social science theory on some of the most fundamental tensions in the global economy, in particular from the developing field of international political economy. We will study how the current economic order evolved historically; debate international economic issues from a variety of perspectives, in particular monetary systems and capital mobility, trade, investment and production, finance and economic development; and analyze the effects of integration on national politics, economic equality and the environment. The objective of the course is to understand the linkages and tension between democracy and capitalism, between national variation and international integration, and to study wealth, inequalities, community, and nature in the global economy.
