### 1) World Bank Graduate scholarship for PSIA students

**The Joint Japan/World Bank Graduate Scholarship Program (JJ/WBGSP)** is open to women and men from developing countries with relevant professional experience and a history of supporting their countries' development efforts who are applying to a master degree program in a development-related topic. A list of PSIA Masters programmes is eligible to this scholarship.
