The **Kuwait Program Student Paper Award** distinguishes outstanding papers written by Master students at Sciences Po, and Master students / fourth year Bachelor students in Kuwait on a topic related to the study of the Arab World or Gulf Region.

At the **Doctoral School** of Sciences Po:

Master programs in <u>History</u>, <u>Political Science</u> and <u>Sociology</u>

At the Paris School of International Affairs of Sciences Po:

· Concentration in Middle East Studies

Requirements

- Proposed papers must deal with questions related to the Arab World or Gulf Region. Papers in all social sciences and the humanities are accepted.
- Proposed papers must have been written as a requirement for validating the course in the fall semester (other types of written deliverables are accepted as well). Ad-hoc papers will not be considered.
- Papers must be written in English.
- Students must be enrolled at the Master level at Sciences Po. Dual degree students and exchange students at the Master level are also eligible.

Paper Submission

- Outstanding papers will be nominated by professors teaching in the above-mentioned courses by Tuesday, May 15th 2018 and sent by email to: morgan.packer@sciencespo.fr with 'Kuwait Program Paper Award Spring 2018" in the subject line.
- Please note that professors may submit no more than 2 papers per course.
- Students will then be contacted to get their approval in taking part in this competition.
- A joint KFAS-Sciences Po committee will review the papers. Results will be announced by June 2018.

<u>Award</u>

The authors of the selected papers will receive a prize of **750 Euros.** Their work will be published on the Kuwait Program website.
