Combining thought with action, Sciences Po is a place where knowledge in the human and social sciences is not only produced and shared, but is also used to confront the complexity of the world.

Renowned for the quality of the education it provides, Sciences Po is the embodiment of a human and social sciences university with an international perspective. A driving force in a university network of excellence, Sciences Po has 470 partnerships with leading institutions and an active policy of innovative and interdisciplinary dual BA programmes.

The common good at the core of our actions

Sciences Po was founded to educate a new generation of stakeholders in society. It is also a pioneer in the development of projects that promote social innovation and inclusion, whether in access to culture, education or healthcare. Working for the common good is what unites all our stakeholders.



For 150 years, Sciences Po has developed a track record as a responsible and creative university. Today, it is one of Europe's largest social science universities, able to offer answers to the major questions raised by the upheavals of contemporary society, training the elites that will transform the world in the future.

A CHANGING WORLD

An unprecedented crisis

The rise of populism, the migration crisis, environmental degradation and deepening inequalities: these increasingly inter-related issues all provoke strong public reactions. This unprecedented situation has resulted in a crisis of legitimacy among decision-makers and experts, leading the most vulnerable populations to feel that they are being abandoned to their fate.

An academic world in motion

The impetus that is emerging today is characterised by greater international openness, a move towards sharing objectives and resources, and the combination of three priorities: research designed to guide decision-making; a multi-disciplinary approach for the cross-fertilisation of perspectives; and impact research via the research – training – experimentation continuum.

A youth in search of renewal

Today's students expect their studies to have both meaning and relevance, paving the way to a future where they can make a real impact on the world. They are even more concerned than their predecessors about putting humanity at the heart of their thought processes. They favour an entrepreneurial approach where agility and getting results count most.

↳ To a diversity of talents

Promoting the success of the many, overcoming discrimination and connecting with audiences that are traditionally beyond the reach of the academia.

Among the projects to build together:

- Support the development of the “Women in business” research programme
- Create social welfare grants
- Make tools such as telepresence robots available for people with disabilities
- Launch of the study certificate for refugees
- Ensure the continuation and sustainability of the pioneering Equal Opportunity Programme (Conventions éducation prioritaire - CEP)

↳ To a broader range of disciplines

The creation of new teaching and research programmes that engage with the life sciences and the humanities.

Among the projects to build together:

- Create research programmes that facilitate dialogue between the social and human sciences and other disciplines, such as the Sciences Po / Mines-Telecom “Good in tech” research programme
- Create a Bachelor of Arts and Sciences degree coordinated between Reims, Le Havre and Paris
- Create a Writing and Rhetoric Centre, and a Writer-in-Residence Chair

↳ To the dynamic countries of the future

Strengthening the global influence of Sciences Po by giving all our teaching programmes an international focus, with Africa as a priority.

Among the projects to build together:

- Develop Sciences Po’s visibility in Africa via the recently-opened office in Kenya
- Create excellence scholarships for foreign students
- Develop the international mobility fund

↳ Around a common history

Promoting the historical and scientific heritage of Sciences Po on its 150th anniversary.

Among the projects to build together:

- Create an institutional portal to facilitate the writing of a collective history of Sciences Po (alumni biographies, the production of a documentary and the digitisation of sound archives)
- Organise an international symposium on Society-Based Knowledge
- Digitise exceptional documentary collections and make them available to the general public

↳ Around a shared institution

The construction of a new campus in the heart of Paris, located around the Artillerie site, providing Sciences Po with the means to constantly reinvent itself and be one of the world's finest universities. A place to study, to produce knowledge and build individual futures together.

Among the projects to build together:

- Create new workspaces: collaborative platforms, innovative teaching and learning spaces
- Provide professional facilities: "incubators", fablabs, a media studio for the School of Journalism
- Create new shared spaces: a cafeteria, a 5,000 sq. m knowledge garden (for teaching, concerts, film screenings, conferences and assemblies), a "Maison des Sciences Po", etc.

↳ Within an alliance of the like-minded

Strengthening strategic university cooperation in our key disciplines.

Among the projects to build together:

- Develop strategic partnerships with LSE, Oxford (OxPo), Cambridge (CamPo), and other key universities in the fields of social and human sciences
- Build the policy of international dual BA programmes
- Strengthen links with other partner institutions that share our high standards

↳ By educating a committed generation

Empowering new generations to act and educating the changemakers for a more responsible and united world.

Among the projects to build together:

- Implement the Etoile project, which combines research, training and entrepreneurial experimentation
- Develop the Public Policy Incubator
- Expand Premier campus, aimed at encouraging secondary school pupils from less privileged backgrounds into higher education
- Launch the Civic Learning Programme, the active learning of citizenship and social responsibility and a mandatory component of the Bachelor's degree

↳ By exploiting digital opportunities

Transforming teaching and research through cutting-edge technology

Among the projects to build together:

- Establish the Sciences Po digital campus (service platform, digital one-stop shop, etc.)
- Carry out research projects at the Medialab and the Socio-Political Data Centre
- Develop and expand digital infrastructures for data processing in research

↳ By rethinking the links between the university and the city

Making the urban campus a model of a welcoming, green, sustainable and accessible university, in harmony with its surroundings.

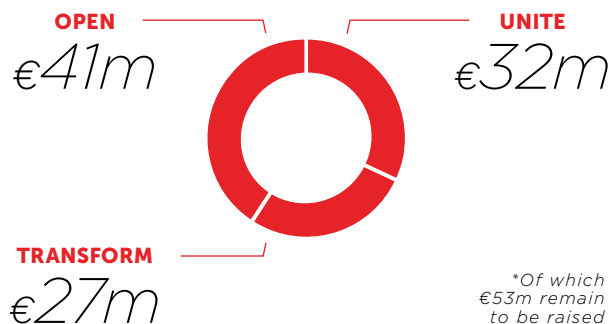
Among the projects to build together:

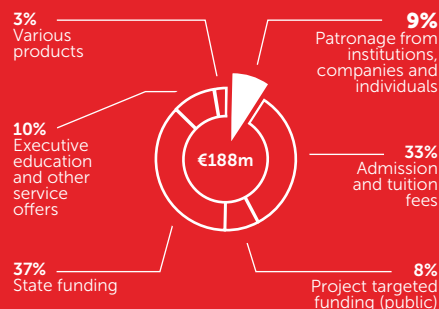
