



JOB POSITION: POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCHER, AT SCIENCES PO, OSC

The LIFETRACK project is a comparative project on the lifelong effects of educational participation. It is funded under the Norface collaborative partnership of some European national research agencies and involves scholars from Germany, France, Great Britain, Finland and Denmark.

The French team based at Sciences Po, Observatoire Sociologique du Changement (OSC) intends to appoint a junior researcher to contribute to the statistical analyses, conduct literature reviews and write research summaries on educational and occupational inequalities.

Skills required:

- Familiarity with Stata, R or SAS routines for data cleaning and multivariate statistical modeling
- Reporting & data visualization skills
- Familiarity with surveys and survey questionnaires
- Proficiency in English required to read articles and questionnaires in this language
- Punctuality, accuracy, ability to learn quickly
- Research doctorate level or research master's degree with previous experiences in data analysis

Eligibility

Candidates should have completed, or be close to completing, a doctorate in Sociology, Statistics or Economics, or have a research master's degree and previous experiences in data analysis.

In the current context of the COVID epidemic, the mission may be carried out entirely by remote working.

4 months full-time position starting on the 4th January, 2021 (part-time could be possible). The Fellow will be affiliated to the OSC, at Sciences Po Paris.
