

STUDENT PODCASTS ON SUSTAINABILITY

Dear students of PSIA and EAP,

The European Chair for Sustainable Development and Climate Transition at Sciences Po is launching a process to form student team(s) who will generate podcasts on sustainability and climate issues in the current (Fall) semester.

The objective of the effort is to have students produce monthly podcasts during the semester. It will be a student-led activity, and podcasts produced with guidance from the Chair. The audience for the podcasts are students at Sciences Po as well as youth in other universities / globally. The Chair would help advertise the podcasts, for example share them with Chair's Scientific Committee, the sponsors, and publishing the podcasts on the Chair's website. As needed, we will also help connect students with experts to be interviewed.

Students who wish to be members of the podcast team must commit to participate during the semester and to engage productively with others in the team. If students wish to remain in the team for the next (Spring) semester, that could be considered at a later date.

Podcasting is an excellent way to develop skills in communication and interviewing, to augment team working proficiencies, as well as a great opportunity to meet interesting people and experts, foster creativity and strengthen research skills.

On receiving expressions of interest from individual students, we will contact short listed candidates before finalizing the podcast team. Depending on the number (of promising students) we may elect to have more than one podcast team for the semester.

Note that this call is open only to current students of PSIA and EAP.
