



CARE Scholarships

Made possible by funding from the Fondation DRG, [CARE](#) is a joint initiative of Sciences Po, University of British Columbia, University of Guelph, and University of Toronto. CARE encourages students to develop the skills, knowledge and experiences needed to generate hands-on solutions to address the triple planetary crisis of climate change, biodiversity loss and pollution.

Scholarships are available for Canadian students to follow graduate studies in topics related to CARE's core themes at Sciences Po's PSIA starting in September 2025.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for the CARE scholarship, Applicants must:

- Be a citizen of Canada,
- Be admitted to a regular 2-year Master program or a Dual Degree in one of the following areas of specialisation:
 - [Environmental Policy](#)
 - [International Energy Transitions](#)

If students are admitted to Dual Degrees, including the [Master in Environmental Science and Policy](#), the scholarship will only cover the first year at PSIA.

The CARE scholarship cannot be combined with other scholarships such as the Eiffel or Boutmy scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

The CARE scholarship provides a significant contribution to student tuition fees and covers some of the living costs in Paris and travel to/from Paris and Canada over both years of the 2-year Master program.

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

For the 2025/26 academic year, candidates for the CARE scholarship must submit their application after they receive the offer of a place on the Master in Environmental Policy or the Master in International Energy Transitions.
