



CARE STUDENT MOBILITY FELLOWSHIPS

Made possible by funding from the Fondation DRG, [CARE](#) is a joint initiative of Sciences Po, University of British Columbia, University of Guelph, and University of Toronto. CARE encourages students to develop the skills, knowledge and experiences needed to generate hands-on solutions to address the triple planetary crisis of climate change, biodiversity loss and pollution.

Mobility fellowships are now available for PSIA students to pursue a Master thesis, an (unpaid) internship or a study exchange on themes related to environmental sustainability, climate change, biodiversity and energy transitions during the third semester 'hors les murs'.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Be a PSIA regular 2-year Master degree student.
- Conduct a third-semester project related to CARE themes (environment, sustainability, biodiversity, energy transitions).
- Conduct a third-semester's project with a connection to Canada (based in Canada or concerned with Canada).

FELLOWSHIP AMOUNT

Successful candidates will receive a contribution of up to € 5000 towards their third semester (Master thesis, internship, exchange semester).

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

Candidates for the CARE Mobility Fellowship must [complete the application form](#) in English by 15 June 2025. Additional documents can be sent via emails to the CARE Program Manager until 10 July 2025.

PSIA will evaluate applications and make decisions about fellowships by 15 July 2025.

The CARE Mobility Fellowships cannot be combined with other mobility fellowships.
