Within the frame of our Memorandum of Understanding, Sciences Po is committed to send up to 2 visiting faculty members to conduct research or to teach in Japan alongside with the invitation of up to 2 researchers from Keio hosted by our researchers.

With world-class research facilities and wide-ranging academic programs in Tokyo, the world's biggest metropolis, Keio is an exciting place to learn, grow, and connect with people from around the world. Opportunity abounds at Keio: learn from leading scholars, conduct advanced research in one of hundreds of labs, and connect with leaders from academia, business, and government.

CONDITIONS

- Duration of the stay: minimum 2 weeks - maximum 1 month
- Eligibility: To be a member of Sciences Po's academic community for more than 6 months and to be under 65 years-old.
- Requirements: to deliver 6 hours of teaching or to be actively involved in a research program.
- Living allowances: from 330.000 up to 430.000 yens per month (depending on the conversion rate, between 2.500 et 3.400 euros)
- Transportation: **Covered by the beneficiary**
- Accommodation: Keio will support the visiting faculty to find affordable accommodation.

APPLICATION

Application materials include the following documents and must be submitted in English:

- A full CV, including a list of publications
- A personal statement, including research project and specificities
- A letter of invitation from a Keio researcher
