Cambridge-Sciences Po academic exchange programme

CamPo is a research partnership between Sciences Po and the University of Cambridge offering an exchange programme for all social science PhD students within the six schools of Cambridge University and PhD students within all of Sciences Po's research centres.

Applications are now open for students to spend a period of time studying in their non-home institution during the **calendar year 2022**.

PhD students whose research would benefit from spending a period of time in the other institution are encouraged to apply to this scheme. Visiting students should arrange their stay so that it coincides with the teaching terms in Cambridge and Paris.

- In Cambridge, visiting CamPo PhD students will be affiliated with a host department and provided with desk space (whenever possible and usually in a shared open space), a library card and access to Cambridge online resources. Students will be assigned a member of the faculty as their institutional point of contact. Visiting CamPo PhD students will be encouraged to play a full part in the academic life of the host department, through participation in seminars and interaction with faculty <http://www.polis.cam.ac.uk/> For your information, please find the term dates for the University of Cambridge: <http://www.cam.ac.uk/univ/termdates.html>
- In Sciences Po, visiting CamPo PhD students will be affiliated with one of the Sciences Po research centres (<http://www.sciencespo.fr/recherche/en/content/research-centers>) and with the Ecole de la Recherche. They will have access to desk space in one of the research centres (whenever possible and usually in a shared open space), a library card and access to Sciences Po online resources. Students will be assigned a member of the faculty as their institutional point of contact (<http://www.sciencespo.fr/en>). At time of advertising, it is acknowledged that Covid-related travel restrictions may make it difficult to plan in advance to undertake an exchange. At this stage, we are asking students to let us know the **details of an exchange they would like to undertake in 2022**, so that permission can be granted in principle. Those selected for the CamPo exchange will then have a full calendar year to undertake their exchange, as and when travel restrictions permit. If for any reason the exchange simply cannot be undertaken in the calendar year 2022, permission will lapse but students will be able to reapply in future rounds if they have not yet completed their PhD.

Entry into the exchange country will be subject to government regulations at the time of travel. A small grant of £250 will be available to assist with the costs of Covid-testing, if required as a condition of travel.

FUNDING AND RESOURCES

The CamPo exchange offers a fee-waiver between Cambridge and Sciences Po. There is no dedicated funding for exchange participants. Participants are advised to contact their institution (College and Department, Ecole de la Recherche and Centres) to enquire about travel funds available to PhD students.

As visiting students, CamPo PhD students will have access to all the institutional support provided at Sciences Po or in Cambridge: at Cambridge, they will be affiliated with a college and, subject to availability, they will be able to rent accommodation through the university/college.

Please note that visiting PhD students at Cambridge whose first language is not English will also have to take and pass an IELTS test.

CAMPO Application process

The **deadline** for applications is **17.00 on 1 October 2021**.

Interested **PhD** students should seek support from an academic sponsor in the Department they wish to visit. If the Department is prepared to support your exchange, in principle, please then submit your application to CamPo PhD Exchanges 2022 via our [Qualtrics survey](#), ensuring all details requested are provided.

Within a month of returning to their home institutions, exchange visitors will be required to provide a short report (2 pages max) about their stay.
