Forgetting and reconnecting to a Wifi network

HOW TO FORGET AND RECONNECT TO THE WIFI NETWORK?

In rare cases, a connection error may occur (when moving from one campus building to another). An error message will be displayed saying "unable to reconnect to the network". If this happens, forget about the wifi network and connect again:



ANDROID

- 1 Access the list of Wifi networks, then click on the settings button for the network on which you wish to disconnect:



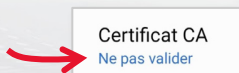
- 2 Click on the "Forget" button:



- 3 Select the network of your choice again to reconnect using your login details. For example, at Sciences Po :

- Your username prenom.nom@sciencespo.fr
- Your Sciences Po account password

- 4 In the CA certificate, select "Do not validate" and click on "Connect".

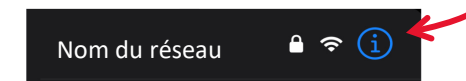


- 5 If your device requests it, re-enter the security settings for the network concerned (see red box on previous page).

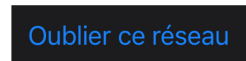


IOS

- 1 Access the list of Wifi networks via the IOS settings menu and click on the network you want to forget:



- 2 Click "Forget this network" to forget the network and confirm by clicking "Forget".



- 3 Select the network of your choice again to reconnect using your usual login details. For example at Science Po :

- Your username prenom.nom@sciencespo.fr
- Your Sciences Po account password

- 4 Click on "Connect" then on "Trust" to validate the connection

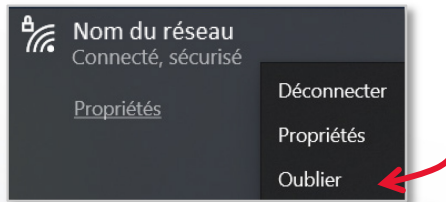

HOW TO FORGET AND RECONNECT TO THE WIFI NETWORK?



PC

- 1 In the Windows status bar (bottom right of the screen), click on the Wifi icon to display the list of **Wifi networks**
- 2 Right-click on the network concerned and click on **"Forget"**:



- 3 Select the network again to reconnect using your usual login details. For example, for Sciences Po :
 - Your username prenom.nom@sciencespo.fr
 - Your Sciences Po account password



MAC

- 1 Click on the Wi-Fi icon in the status bar at the top of the screen, then click on **"WiFi Settings..."** : Réglages Wi-Fi...
- 2 Find the network you want to forget and reconnect to:



If the Wifi network currently in use is the one you want to forget, click on the **"Details..."** button.

If the Wifi network currently in use is not the one you want to forget, locate it in the **"Known networks"** list and click on the **"More"** button.

- 3 Click on "Forget this network" and then on "Delete".
- 4 In the Spotlight search (magnifying glass button at the top of the screen), type "keychain" and click on Keychain. The list of wifi certificates appears. You must delete all certificates ending in "@sciencespo.fr".
- 5 If the connection still does not work, restart the Mac.
