

## STEPHEN M. KELLEN SCHOLARSHIP

The Stephen M. Kellen Scholarship is a merit-based scholarship designed to attract the brightest and most deserving students to the Dual BA program between Sciences Po and Freie Universität Berlin.

It encourages promising young individuals to commit to Europe by giving them the keys to law, economics, history, political science, and sociology; the opportunity to speak at least three languages; and the ability to navigate in both German and French cultures.

### • ELIGIBILITY

The candidate must be admitted at Sciences Po's dual BA with Freie Universität Berlin (application welcome without knowing the admission results).

The Scholarship is awarded to a student who exemplifies the values promoted by Stephen M. Kellen:

- Excellence – as reflected in academic achievement
- Vision – as demonstrated through a written submission on a selected topic
- Generosity – as shown in a commitment to service to others

### • THE VALUE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship covers both tuition fees at Sciences Po and most of the student's living expenses for the two years in France at Sciences Po's French-German European campus in Nancy (\$6,000 per year) and offers a stipend of \$7,000 per year for the two years at the Otto-Suhr-Institut of Freie Universität Berlin.

### • APPLICATION and SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants must send the following to [scholarship@usscpo.org](mailto:scholarship@usscpo.org), before June 20, 2018.

- Application form
- Personal statement describing motivation for studying in the city of Berlin (1,000 words- in english)
- Essay on "The future of Europe" (2,000 words- in english)

The Selection Committee is composed of one representative of the Anna Maria and Stephen Kellen Foundation, one representative of the US Sciences Po Foundation and one representative of Sciences Po.
