INTAKE **ESSENTIALS**

Administrative registration

Proceed with your <u>administrative</u>
<u>registration</u> through your <u>online</u> <u>student</u>
<u>account</u>, in accordance with <u>the</u>
<u>registration calendar</u>. This will allow you to determine the amount of your <u>tuition</u>
<u>fees</u>, choose your payment method and obtain your <u>student card</u>.

CVEC

In order to complete your administrative registration, you will need to pay the Student Life and Campus Contribution (CVEC), of 100€ per year. All the students enrolled in higher education in France are required to pay the CVEC to the Crous, through the following website:

Non-academic student services

Take full advantage of our **Student Services:** you can receive guidance concerning the processing and renewal of your <u>residence permit</u>, the French healthcare system, opening a French bank account, <u>housing opportunities</u>, student jobs, information on public transport, **student welfare**...

Disability and accessibility

The <u>Disability Support Service</u> is here to make the necessary arrangements in regards to your needs and the teaching formats, facilitate communication between you and your teaching staff.

For any questions related to a temporary or permanent disability or disabling health condition, please contact the <u>dedicated</u> <u>person</u>, regardless of your campus.

Health centre

Dedicated to the health and welfare of all students, the <u>Health Centre</u> is here to inform and support you and to help you finding an adapted health professional, if needed. The Health centre provides with free consultations (infirmary, general practitioners, psychological support unit), with or without an appointment, on all campuses.

<u>Wellness and stress management</u> <u>workshops</u> are also organised on most campuses.

Student Health ambassadors

INTAKE FOCUS: HEALTH COVERAGE AND INSURANCES

HEALTH COVERAGE

French social security

Registration to the French social security is free for all students. The social security system reimburses 70% of doctor's bills and 30% or 65% of medicine costs.

How to register?

Depending on your situation, you may have to go through different administrative steps. Check your status here.

What about the top-up insurance?

Registration with a student top-up insurance (mutuelle étudiante) is optional but strongly recommended. It ensures a better rate of reimbursement of your health care costs and will top up the share of the costs that the social security covers and even covers some costs that the social security does not cover.

You can only sign up for a student top-up insurance scheme (mutuelle étudiante) if you are registered with the French social security system.

Your insurances

You are granted an insurance package every year. This coverage includes liability, defence-assistance and repatriation and it is offered by Sciences Po to all the students who have completed their registration process. You can download your insurance leaflets and certificates from your student account, "Administrative certificates" section.

What is civil liability?

Civil liability guarantees the payment of material or physical damages caused by the insured person to a third person. Damages may be caused by negligence, imprudence, by the insured person's children, pets or things he/she is responsible for.

Housing insurance

In France it is mandatory for tenants to take out multi-risk home insurance. An "assurance habitation" policy insures you for rental risks, fire, water damage, natural disasters and theft.

The lessor will ask for proof of insurance coverage when you take possession of the rental. Not having insurance coverage is grounds for immediate cancellation of your lease.



Are you going abroad?

Remember to check your health coverage needs, depending on your destination country! A top-up insurance may be useful or required.

Your civil liabilty and repatriation insurances are also valid abroad. Check the services offered abroad on the insurance leaflets, available in your student area. You can also access <u>Cytric</u> to plan your trips.
