## **ERASMUS+**

## Decision to set the 2025-2026 funding rates

The amount of the Erasmus+ grant varies each year according to the budget allocated to Sciences Po by the European Commission under the Erasmus+ programme and the number of people on mobility in Europe.

Depending on the budget available, beneficiaries may be partial recipients in order to allow all students on study or on internship mobility to receive the Erasmus+ grant.

For the year 2025-2026, funding corresponds to <u>83% of the actual duration of the mobility</u>. Thus, for an actual mobility duration of 10 months, the grant covers 8,3 months of scholarship.

The monthly payment for the year 2025-2026 corresponds to:

- €292 for mobilities towards Group 1 countries ;
- €225 for mobilities towards Group 2 countries.

A monthly supplement of €150 is paid for internship mobilities.

The Erasmus+ grant package varies according to the cost of living in the host country and the duration of the stay. The European Commission has classified the destination countries into two groups and defined the monthly ranges for each mobility category:
